KHAT: Information for the public

KHAT - the law is changing

KHAT is a green-leafed shrub that is chewed for its mild stimulant effects. It is grown in the Horn of Africa, the Arabian peninsula, eastern and southern Africa. KHAT is imported into the UK and mainly used by people in Somali, Ethiopian, Eritrean and Yemeni communities.



- From 2014, it will be **ILLEGAL** to buy, sell, share and use KHAT in the United Kingdom.
- From 2014 it will be against the law to chew KHAT in public, in mafreshi, in your own home, someone else's house or even places of worship.
- From 2014, you must not use KHAT and drive this will be "drug driving".
- From 2014, if the Police find that you have KHAT in your home, in your car, in a public place or on your person (in your pockets or bag) you could be warned, fined or arrested. If you are convicted of possession you will have a **criminal record**, this may make it difficult for you to get a job, driving license, travel visa or insurance.
- If the police suspect a person may be in possession of KHAT in a public place, they will have powers to stop and search that person. If the police believe that KHAT is being kept, produced or supplied in a private place, they may obtain a warrant to search that place.
- Possession of KHAT will attract a range of penalties, for a first offence this will be a 'khat warning', a fixed penalty notice for disorder (£60 fine) for a second offence, followed by arrest and prosecution for repeat offences, which may result in a fine, imprisonment or both.
